WHY RECYCLE LEAD ACID BATTERIES?

- Recycling batteries keeps heavy metals out of the landfill and the air.
- Recycling saves resources because recovered plastic and metals can be used to make new batteries.
- Batteries contain heavy metals such as mercury, lead, cadmium, and nickel, which contaminate the environment when batteries are improperly disposed of.
- Recycling conserves energy since it takes less energy to produce new products from recycled materials.
- It saves natural resources that cannot be replaced.



WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR ACID BATTERIES

LEAD ACID/CAR BATTERIES

- Lead acid batteries can be taken to the landfill or garages or any retailer that sells lead acid batteries.
- Do not place lead acid batteries with in the regular garbage.

SMALL /AA/AAA BATERIES

 Place small batteries in a clear plastic container with a lid. And bring it to the Landfill or place by the Blue Aluminum recycling container for pick-up.
