It is **illegal**, according to the Public Health Law and the Litter Law, to dispose of garbage by throwing it on public or private property, such as deserted or open lots.

A CI \$ 500 fine can be issued under the Litter Law and

a CI \$ 1,000 fine can be issued under the Public Health Law.
